


IPR PROGRAME- RESEARCH METHODOLOGY AND PUBLICATION ETHICS



A Five Day Faculty Development Program on "Research Methodology and Publication Ethics" was organized by Research and Post Graduate Department of Physics, Sree Narayana College, Kollam in association with DBT STAR College Scheme and in academic collaboration with The Kerala State Higher Education Council. This FDP was intended to orient participants towards developing their own understanding of research with due attention to every phase of research.


In the FDP, the classes were in live mode. There are no registration fees were collected from the participants. The course materials were uploaded in online platform. Assignments based on day activities were given. Responses received were also good. E-Participation Certificates will be given to all qualified participants. In the first session Dr. Anilkumar K M, delivered talk on Plagiarism and software to check plagiarism. He also highlighted the importance of the Review of Literature and writing it correctly. He also described how to make references and bibliographies. In the second day, Dr. Sibi K S introduced the Objectives of Research, Research Perspective and relevance of Literature Review in his talk. In the third session, Dr. Sajan K S talked about the ethical standards for high quality of scientific distributions and credibility of scientific findings. In the fourth day Dr. Rakesh Chandran S B, delivered a talk on how to write quality research paper and explained how to choose a journal. He also talked about Open access and publications initiatives in India. In the final day, Dr. Sajan K S, rendered about various software tools for improving the reproducibility and reusability of research. He also forwarded some recommendations to encourage best practices in research software. The sessions helped the participants to understand that Ph.D. is a life long journey and the researcher must follow ethical guidelines issued by regulatory committees in order to ensure the safety of the participants of a study, the public at large, and that of the researcher himself. All the sessions were very much informative. The discussed areas are of great benefit for the participants as the topics match with the current research work. Participants were enlightened and benefitted with the wisdom of the speakers. The FDP received a warm feedback from all the participants. Out of 84 registered candidates, 45 candidates successfully completed the FDP.


