## **Interactive, Co-learning: Workshop on Philosophy, Methods and Ethics in Science**

The P.G. and research department of Chemistry, SN College, Kollam organized a three day workshop on *Philosophy, Methods and Ethics in Science* from 18-20 April 2018 in association with Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI), Chennai and Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE), Trivandrum. The main aim of the workshop is to upgrade, refine and improve the qualities of teaching faculties to help themselves for a better research and teaching style. Modern science has an important influence on the development of society as a whole, compared with the days of the ill-fated Bruno. But while scientific progress has been rapid and astonishing, it is still disturbing for those people who feel excluded from the debate surrounding the application of science in new technologies and products. Furthermore, as scientific progress becomes increasingly fundamental to society, it is constantly challenging if not completely clashing with long-held beliefs concerning our ethical values. It is, therefore, necessary to conduct ethical discussions in order to adapt the use of

scientific knowledge—namely new forms of technology—to a general context that is in agreement with the basic principles of our civilization. Scientists should be concerned about the use of scientific knowledge and they should address the ensuing ethical questions, both in general terms and in terms of their own work.

The resource persons of the workshop were Dr.K.Vijayakumaran (Former Director FSI, Principal Scientist CMFRI, Chennai) and Dr.K.V.Jayachandran (Former Director & Dean of KUFOS, Kochi). Twenty teachers and research scholars from various colleges participated in the workshop. The inaugural programme started at 9.30 AM in G2 seminar hall with the prayer song Dr.B.T.Sulekha, Asst.Prof, Dept.of Zoology, S.N.College, Kollam welcomed the gathering. Dr.V.L.Pushpa (Convenor and HoD) presided over the function.
