Undergraduate Programme Outcomes - BA/BSc/BCom

PO1	Self-directed and Life-long Learning: Self-equipped to engage in independent and life-long learning in the broadest context of socio-cultural and technological changes.
PO2	Effective Communication: Speak, read, write and listen clearly in person and through electronic media in English and in one Indian language, and make meaning of the world by connecting people, ideas, books, media and technology.
