MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") made on 05/06/2019 between Department of Political Science, Sree Narayana College, Kollam (herein referred to as "SNCK") and Junior Chamber International, Quilon (herein referred to as "JCI") by mutual consent. The SNCK and JCI, collectively referred to as the "Institutions" or the "Parties",

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Parties.
2. Each Party agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
 - 2.1) Joint projects in fields of mutual interests

5. Both Parties agree that prior written approval is required before using the other Party's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.

8. This MoU is valid for a period of One year from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each Party. Each Party shall review the status of the MoU at least one month before the end of the period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both Parties.

9. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than one month before the termination date.

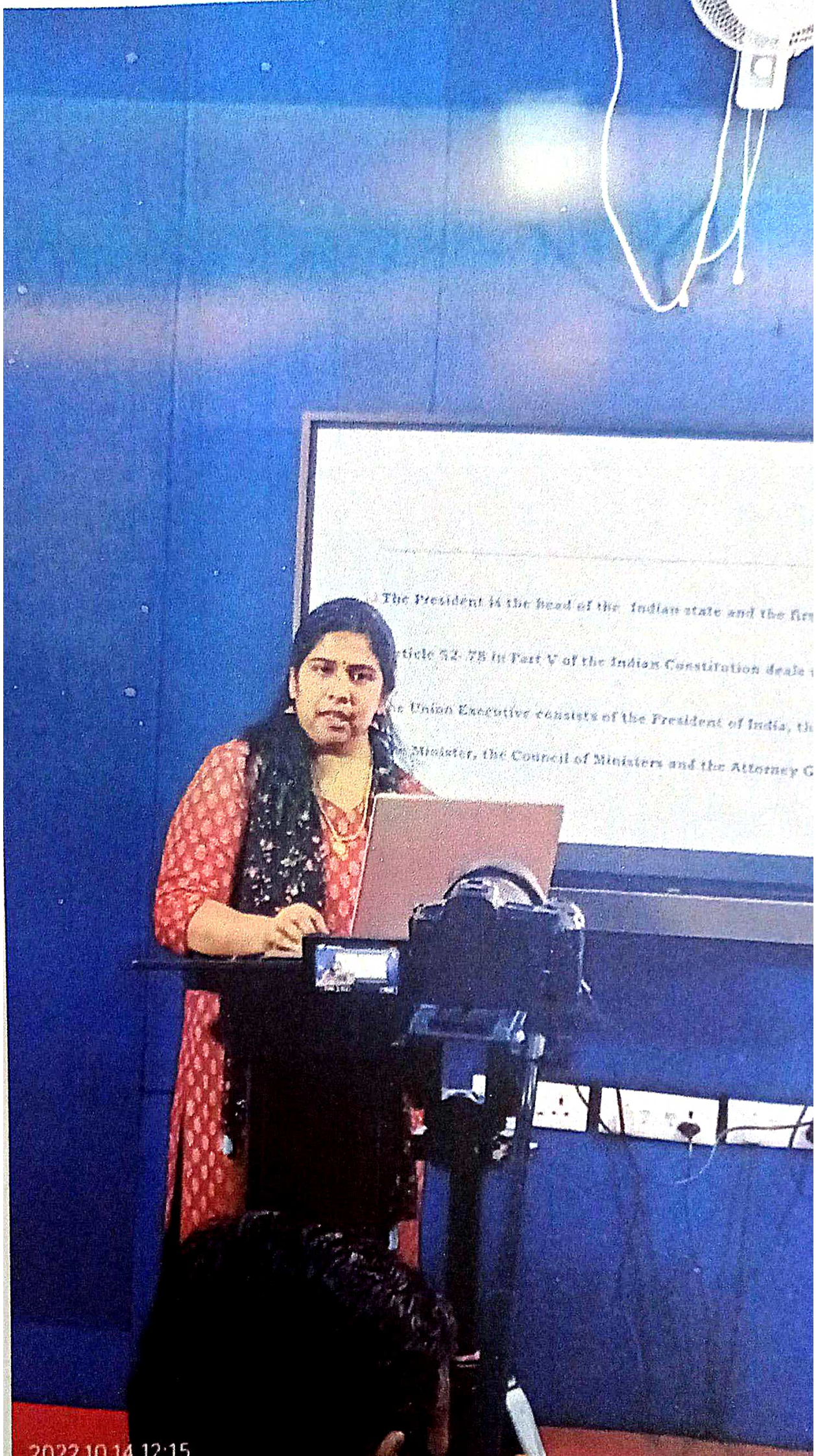
