



Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

On Academic Cooperation Between

Department of English, Sree Narayana College, Kollam, Kerala, India

&

Department of English, Bishop Moore College, Mavelikara, Kerala, India

Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") made on 10/06/2021 between Department of English, Sree Narayana College, Kollam (herein referred to as "SNCK") affiliated to University of Kerala, and Department of English, Bishop Moore College, Mavelikara, (herein referred to as "BMC") affiliated to University of Kerala by mutual consent. The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Institutions" or the "Parties",

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Parties.
2. Each Party agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

2.1) Joint research projects in fields of mutual interests .

2.2) Opportunities for faculty development and exchange as mutually agreed

2.3) Exchange of academic information and materials

2.4) Training on Learning Management Systems and other digital technologies used
in

E- learning to faculty and students.

2.5) Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed.

2.6) Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.

2.7) Other activities as mutually agreed .

3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the parties. Each Party agrees to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective management after full consultation and approval.

4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.

5. Both Parties agree that prior written approval is required before using the other Party's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.

6. This Agreement places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either Party.

7. This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each Party.

8. This MoU is valid for a period of One year from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each Party. Each Party shall review the status of the MoU at least one month before the end of the period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both Parties.

9. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than one month before the termination date.


