INTRODUCTION

Kerala State Biodiversity Board (KSBB) is planning to establish 'Biodiversity Clubs' in Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools in order to implement programmes to conserve biodiversity in a timely manner. Biodiversity Conservation programmes will be conducted by the Biodiversity Clubs in University Campus, Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools. These biodiversity clubs will carry out programmes for conservation of local biodiversity in accordance with Biodiversity Acts, in association with local Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs). In addition, these clubs will also establish 'Shanthisthal', a man-made forest ecosystem in the colleges, where at least a minimum of 10-20 cents would be made available for making a forest grove with RET (Rare, Endangered and Threatened) species. This protected Shanthisthal maintained by the Biodiversity Club of the college in due course of time will become a biodiversity rich area of rare and endangered plant and animal species without human hindrance.

The main objectives of establishing the Biodiversity Clubs include

- In association with BMCs conduct biodiversity studies.
- Involve in the activities of forming People's Biodiversity Registers
- Assessing the local biodiversity and come up with programmes on benefit sharing of biodiversity resources in association with BMCs
- Conducting awareness programmes on biodiversity conservation
- Equip younger generation to create biodiversity awareness in the community
- Help to materialise Biodiversity conservation plans proposed by BMC of the area

Organisational structure Biodiversity clubs will have an organisational structure as given below:

Patron	: Principal of the College
Coordinator	: A teacher committed to biodiversity studies and conservation activities
Executive committee	: Three teachers and two students who are Interested in conservation/ protection of environment, one member of PTA
Invitees	: KSBB District Coordinator, One BMC member, Local Forest Officer and Local Agricultural Officer

The club shall have a minimum of 50 members drawn from various classes and shall not be gender based.

Guidelines for establishment of 'Shanthisthal'

- There shall be at least 10-20 cents available for establishing the 'Shanthisthal'
- The forest grove being made in the allotted land, shall be only with RET and local varieties of trees/ plants
- The State Biodiversity Board will offer financial support for initial establishment/ protection
- In course of time the forest grove referred to as 'Shanthisthal' would be an assembling of plant/ tree varieties of RET species and also would automatically enrich the faunal elements
- The teachers/ students shall maintain 'Shanthisthal' in a sustainable manner so that the future generations of students and the local community will get benefit out of it

- Once the trees/ plants are established, the local/ scientific names are to be displayed so that the Shanthisthal will also have an educative value
- In course of time a 'register' with the plants and animals in the 'Shanthisthal' to be prepared and maintained in the College for reference

Activity Report 2020-2021

Some of the activities are listed below:

1. Observation of World Environmental Day

World Environment Day was celebrated with various students activities on 5th June 2020. Biodiversity club in association with Department of Botany organize a digital poster making competition among college students through online mode. 17 students from our college registered the programme. Vignesh K, Second Year BSc Mathematics of our college Bagged First Prize.

2. Planting new seedlings at Santhisthal

The main activity of the club is to maintain the shanthisthal, a garden of rare and endangered and threatened (RET) plants. Students were entrusted to plant seedlings of fruit trees at Shanthisthal. Each tree seedling was planted by students and maintained it.

3. Regular maintaining activities at Santhisthal

The club members make four groups among themselves to perform the maintenance activities at Shanthisthal. Each day one group perform weeding, watering and other activity at evening time. Likewise all the four groups perform their activity from Monday to Thursday. Friday all the four groups jointly perform the activities. Possible Saturdays all the group members and coordinators were assembled at Shanthisthal to perform campus cleaning, weeding etc

4. Ozone Day 2020 Celebration

World Ozone day 2020 was celebrated in association with Department of Zoology, Bhoomithra Sena Club and Nature Club. The ozone layer, a fragile shield of gas, protects the Earth from the harmful portion of the rays of the sun, thus helping preserve life on the planet. The phaseout of controlled uses of ozone depleting substances and the related reductions have not only helped protect the ozone layer for this and future generations, but have also contributed significantly to global efforts to address climate change; furthermore, it has protected human health and ecosystems by limiting the harmful ultraviolet radiation from reaching the Earth. This year, we celebrate 35 years of the Vienna Convention and 35 years of global ozone layer protection. Life on Earth would not be possible without sunlight. But the energy emanating from the sun would be too much for life on Earth to thrive were it not for the ozone layer. This stratospheric layer shields Earth from most of the sun's harmful ultraviolet radiation. Sunlight makes life possible, but the ozone layer makes life as we know it possible.

World Ozone Day, held on September 16, celebrates this achievement. It shows that collective decisions and action, guided by science, are the only way to solve major global crises. In this year of the COVID-19 pandemic that has brought such social and economic hardship, the ozone treaties' message of working together in harmony and for the

collective good is more important than ever. The slogan of the day, 'Ozone for life', reminds us that not only is ozone crucial for life on Earth, but that we must continue to protect the ozone layer for future generations.

A webinar was organized to celebrate World Environmental Day 2020 on 16 September 2020 through Google meet platform. The programme was presided by our Principal Dr. R Sunilkumar and inaugurated by Dr C. Anilkumar, Senior Principle Scientist, Science Education Division, KSCSTE, Thiruvananthapuram. The Resource person was Dr AA Muhammed Hatha, Professor, Dept. of Marine Biology and Biochemistry, School of Marine Science, Cochin University of Science and Technology. He delivered an excellent speech on Ozone depletion- implication for life on earth. Welcome address was made by Dr S Sheeba and Vote of thanks was delivered by Dr S Sankar.

The Academic Collaboration was extended by Kerala State Council for Science Technology and Environment, Thiruvananthapuram. 75 students and faculty members participated in the webinar.




5. International Day for Biological Diversity



Department of Botany, SreeNarayana College, Kollam in association with the Biodiversity club of the institution, conducted a webinar on the topic

“Biodiversity conservation with Remote sensing and GIS” on the international day for biological diversity 22.05.2021. The webinar is conducted through Google meet platform. It started at 10:30 am. Anchoring of the session is done by Ms. Anjana Kartha J , IInd MSc student of Botany department. The prayer song was sung by Ms, Anuvindha A of the same department. Welcome speech was delivered by Dr. Nisha A P, Head of the department of Botany. In the welcome speech teacher said that “Biodiversity conservation is the aim of the webinar” and we are the part of the solution for the biodiversity conservation.

1. Webinar on Nudges in daily life


“A Nudge is any small feature in the environment that attracts our attention and alters our behavior.” -Richard Thaler

One day webinar was organized as a part of financial literacy club on 16st March 2021 in order to spread financial literacy among the students our college. The programme started with a silent prayer. Dr. Dhanya R coordinator of the programme delivered welcome speech, Dr.R. Sunilkumar (Principal, SN College, Kollam) delivered Inaugural address. Dr. Vineet K M (Assistant Professor, Govt. College, Thripunithura) was the recourse person of the programme. He emphasized on the impact of nudges in our daily life. The recourse person explained the most relevant aspects of nudges in the daily life of human beings. **Nudges are just elements of an environment or details of a product that influence people to get them to act in a certain way.** Nudging has become a well renowned concept in policymaking around the globe, supporting active behavior changes like higher retirement saving, healthier nutrition or saving natural resources. Nudge-interventions aim at changing individuals’ behaviors without limiting their

freedom of choice, exerting coercion or significantly changing economic incentives. As nudging still impairs individuals' autonomy, the concept has evoked heated debates about its ethical acceptability. The importance of ethical considerations when designing and implementing nudge-interventions has been acknowledged

II Webinar on option trading strategies

Financial literacy club organized another webinar on 19.03.2021 about option trading strategies. The programme started with a silent prayer. Dr. Dhanya R coordinator of the programme delivered welcome speech; Dr.R. Sunilkumar (Principal, SN College, Kollam) delivered Inaugural address. Dr. Madhusudhanan kartha N V (Assistant Professor, Govt. College, Chalakkudy) was the recourse person of the programme. He thoroughly explained the strategies on option trading.

Options are a form of derivative contract that gives buyers of the contracts the right (but not the obligation) to buy or sell a security at a chosen price at some point in the future. Option buyers are charged an amount called a "premium" by the sellers for such a right. Should market prices be unfavorable for option holders, they will let the option expire worthless and not exercise this right, ensuring that potential losses are not higher than the premium. On the other hand, if the market moves in the direction that makes this right more valuable, it will be made use of. The

resource person emphasized the major strategies for option trading like covered call, bull put spread, bear put spread and Protective Collar.







3. International Day for Biological Diversity




REPORT

The main purpose of the Media Club is to provide an opportunity to students to be creative in media. Using media, they will collaborate together while getting hands-on experience. It also aims at providing encouragement and technical know-how on the various mass communication media. It also gives an opportunity to the students to be creative in media and to enhance their creative skills. It enables students to develop an understanding of the effects of mass media on themselves as individuals and also upon society and to build up skills to deconstruct media messages by making them understand the constructed nature of media.

The Co-ordinator of the Media Club is Mrs.Radhika B., Assistant Professor of English and the members include Smt. Chinnu Chandran, Assistant Professor of English, Dr.Smitha Prakash, Assistant Professor of Malayalam, Smt.Preseeja P.J., Assistant Professor of Commerce, and Dr.Bera R.Uday, Assistant Professor of Sanskrit.

The Media Club of Sree Narayana College, Kollam, organized several programmes during the academic year 2020-2021. A webinar on “Polyphony of Folk Songs” was conducted on 03th August 2020 in association with the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication and IQAC. Mr. Rahul Gandhi Folklore Researcher, Director of Thudi Folklore and recipient of Kerala Government’s Young Talent Award as the chief guest and he enumerated on the different types of folk songs and how it reflects the culture of different communities in Kerala. The session was a very interactive one and with examples he discussed about the origin of some folksongs and how it is related to the life of the people and how important are folksongs in determining and understanding the life, culture, and social practices of people. He also talked about the connection between folksongs and the Malayalam language.

The aim of the seminar was to make the students aware of the importance of folklore as an art form and how it reflects the beliefs, hopes, aspirations, rituals, traditions and culture of the people from whom it originated and how important are folksongs, which has become so popular in the twenty-first century, from the anthropological, historical, literary and artistic perspective.

An online cloud platform in telegram which was formed in 2019 to share critically acclaimed world movies, documentaries and also photographs and other media that should not be left ignored, continued to share acclaimed movies and documentaries. The aim was to foster global awareness of life and culture to the students, as visual clips provide a greater understanding of the time and era and also of the locale in which the story is set. These movies, documentaries and photographs were also aimed at sensitizing students to environmental, gender and refugee issues.

Discussions and review of movies were organized, in association with the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, as it plays an important part in understanding the films better. Different aspects of a film like the effectiveness of the storyline and dialogue, the importance of background, the role played by photography, costume, the use of darkness and light, performance of actors, the importance of editing, were discussed. Students were also made aware of how to interpret and analyse movies objectively.

An online photography contest was conducted on the topic “Life in Pandemic Times.” Out of the several entries received three were selected and the students were given certificates of appreciation. It was aimed at encouraging students to observe their world even when the world was locked down due to the pandemic and the photographs reflected the dull monotony of lockdown days.

An RJ hunt was also conducted in order to enhance and encourage communicative and interactive skills among the students. Students were encouraged to send a one minute audio clip on any topic showcasing the power of their voice and they could use either Malayalam or English. The aim was to find talented students and to make them industry ready.

These activities helped the student community to widen their knowledge about folklore, films, documentaries, photography, film appreciation, the dos and don'ts of being a RJ and also the various elements and techniques involved in the media. The activities also helped the students to become aware of various career opportunities in mass media and also the significance and impact of conveying messages through media.
