MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the **9th day of July** Two Thousand and Twenty (**09/07/2020**), by and between

AND

Sanskrita Bharathi, Kollam, Kerala, and represented herein by its Zonal / Divisional Head, **Name of Competent Authority / Representative**, (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

Sree Narayana College, Kollam.

B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

C) The Parties intent to co-operate and focus their efforts on co-operation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.



D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for
advancing their mutual interests.

E) **Sanskrita Bharati**, the Second Party is engaged in Skill Development, Education and in the fields of **propagating Sanskrit language and Sanskrit Villages** and related fields

F) **Sanskrita Bharati**, the Second Party is promoted by **Sanskrita Bharati, Kottapuram;**
Sanskrita Bharati, Kottapuram, Trissur.

G) Sanskrita Bharati an organization that has been propagating Sanskrit language and literature and propagating Sanskrit Villages.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH
IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

CLAUSE 1

CO- OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the organization, the Second Party.

1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.



**CLAUSE 2 SCOPE
OF THE MoU**

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an organization. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the organizational scenario meaningfully.

2.3 **Visit to Sanskrit propagating Village:** Organization and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the Organization; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit Sanskrit propagating villages and also involve in Training Programs for the First Party. The training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its facilities for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of **propagating Sanskrit language and literature, propagating spoken Sanskrit Villages, proficiency in spoken Sanskrit training, research activities and services.**

2.5 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them ready.

2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the new trends and in house requirements.

2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

2.8 **Placement of Trained Students:** Second Party is a non profitable organization, and students who successfully completed the six month course on 'proficiency in Spoken Sanskrit Training' are qualified as spoken Sanskrit trainers.

2.9 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein



2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Department of Sanskrit, Sree Narayana College, Kollam, Kerala**, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY


4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **Sanskrita Bharati, Kollam, Kerala**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES


5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Profile of the College

Department of Sanskrit, Sree Narayana College, Kollam.

Name of the Course - **Certificate Programme in Sanskrit Proficiency.**

Course Duration - Six Months.

Background

There is a growing community of Sanskrit lovers due to personal or professional reasons. They are catered by traditional Sanskrit courses which are time consuming or general Sanskrit texts which are unguided. Most available Sanskrit classes work on general interest spoken Sanskrit basis or adopt a classical Sanskrit teaching approach. In short, the current methods and mechanisms to transmit the knowledge of Sanskrit are neither limited nor cater to an optimum possible audience. There is a lack of enough proficient spoken Sanskrit trainers too who know the nuances of domain-specific knowledge of Sanskrit linking with modern times.

Rationale of the Course

The proposed approach attempts to train Sanskrit Trainers or Sanskrit Speaking Consultants who can provide an in-person guided Spoken Sanskrit Courses. There will be *General Spoken Sanskrit* and *Advanced Sanskrit* specialised for new-economy knowledge areas. It attempts to link Sanskrit to the modern job market and economy, which is the first and unique attempt in South India.

Also, we propose to set-up a mini-Sanskrit Lab as part of the course. The lab will be composed of spoken tutorials, study materials in digital formats, apps, websites, Virtual Reality programmes for Sanskrit Learners and other related facilities.

Objectives of the course

1. To create a new cadre of *Trainers of Spoken Sanskrit* and to make available their service in different areas or sectors of knowledge and economy.
2. To give students a clearer and practical foundation of Sanskrit as a living language to apply it in a variety of other contemporary fields.
3. To facilitate the understanding of simple texts and core vocabulary to other professional groups such as Ayurveda, tourism, museum studies, Vedic mathematics, Vasthusasthra, linguistics, computer-science, Manuscript preservation and art forms such as koodiyattam and Astapadi.

Outcome and uniqueness of the Course

By the end of the course, the student will be able to decode knowledge of Sanskrit in different contexts. They will be able to understand Sanskrit narratives, communicate in simple Sanskrit, and analyze the grammar of any basic text. Apart from this they will be able assist others for learning simple Spoken Sanskrit. The course is also unique in terms of its delivery. The methodology will be using a combination of classic and modern teaching approaches to cater the Generation Z learners.

Job Market

The job market is spread across different industries. One is Ayurveda. For example, the Kerala Ayurveda industry stands to benefit out of the various developmental schemes from central and state machineries like Ayush and MSME. This will create opportunities in the healthcare market, particularly Ayush sector. Ayurveda tourism is an associated area though it will take much only in the post COVID-19 season.

The market for cultural and heritage studies is another area. Traditional institutions where there can be add-on courses by specialised trainers is another market. Digitisation, publications, archaeology and heritage sciences are also potential areas for placements. The following job roles will illustrate this.

Job Roles

Spoken Sanskrit Trainers

There is a growing group of professionals and common people who like to learn Sanskrit for general interest or for hobby. They need spoken Sanskrit trainers.

Specialised Sanskrit Assistants or independent Sanskrit Consultants

There are professional areas like Ayurveda, museum studies, Vedic-mathematics, Vasthusasthra, linguistics, programming, Manuscript preservation and art forms such as Koodiyattam and Astapadii where the knowledge of Sanskrit will allow the professionals to function with better efficiency and higher knowledge. Our candidates will be suitable to assist those professionals and train them in Spoken Sanskrit or work as independent consultants for the requirements related to Sanskrit language.

Translators, interpreters and content creators

Highly proficient students can work as Interpreters, translators and content creators for literary ventures, websites and programmes. Translators work with written material while interpreters work with spoken Sanskrit and vernacular or English. Content creators work with websites for creating Sanskrit related content.

- **Internship orientation**
- **Selection of internship**
- **Nature of work:** Complete a field work in any area of Sanskrit which can be applied in the real world. Some examples include, to teach conversational Sanskrit to a group of persons, to prepare a practical glossary to be used by Ayurvedic practitioners, to set-up a virtual Sanskrit assistance centre etc.
