REPORT

A department meeting was held on 4th August, 2017 at 9:30 am in the department. The certificate course titled "Indian Government and Politics" started on 07th August, 2017 to 10th September 2017. The course has been designed to be 30 days long with regular classes. The course began with an inaugural session where Dr. Anitha Sankar (Principal, SNC Kollam) inaugurated the program officially. Dr. Maya P. (HOD, Dept. of Political Science) gave the presidential address. The consecutive classes were handled by experts in the field of Indian Constitution. A total of thirty classes were given to the students, out of which there were twenty-five live classes and the rest five classes were assigned with projects as instructed by their teachers. Apart from the classes taken by experts, the students were also provided with study materials which had detailed notes about their topics. After the completion of class, the students were given an examination of three-hour duration out of 80 marks. All students attended the examination and gained above fifty percent marks thereby passing the course and but five students are failed. After course the students were provided with regular form to submit their feedback about the course they attended. A very good and positive feedback was received from the side of students making the program a grand success.

PROGRAMME OUTCOME

The Political science programme determination help the students to understand how governments operate and interact, the impact of government policies upon economic stability and growth, and how laws effect social and political change.

The programme aims at promoting democratic values among the students and to familiarise them with the basic structure of our polity. A knowledge enriched with long cherished ideas will lead the students to develop citizenship qualities and to critical analysis of the political process.

Undergraduate political science students can participate in government or nonprofit organizations in the form of internships to prepare for their careers.

The political science students can participate in courses spanning the sub-fields of political processes, judicial behavior, political theory, international and comparative politics as well as public administration, state and local government.

Occupational opportunities include government administration, politics and campaigns, public policy, non-profit organizations, international relations, media studies and journalism. Students are also prepared to pursue Post- graduate programs in area studies, Environment studies law and diplomacy.

The students are taught about how political power is distributed, different governments operate and interact and rules are made and enforced. The programme explore both the "who" of politics (such as politicians, international organizations, and the public) and the "how" (such as elections, political institutions, and public administration).
