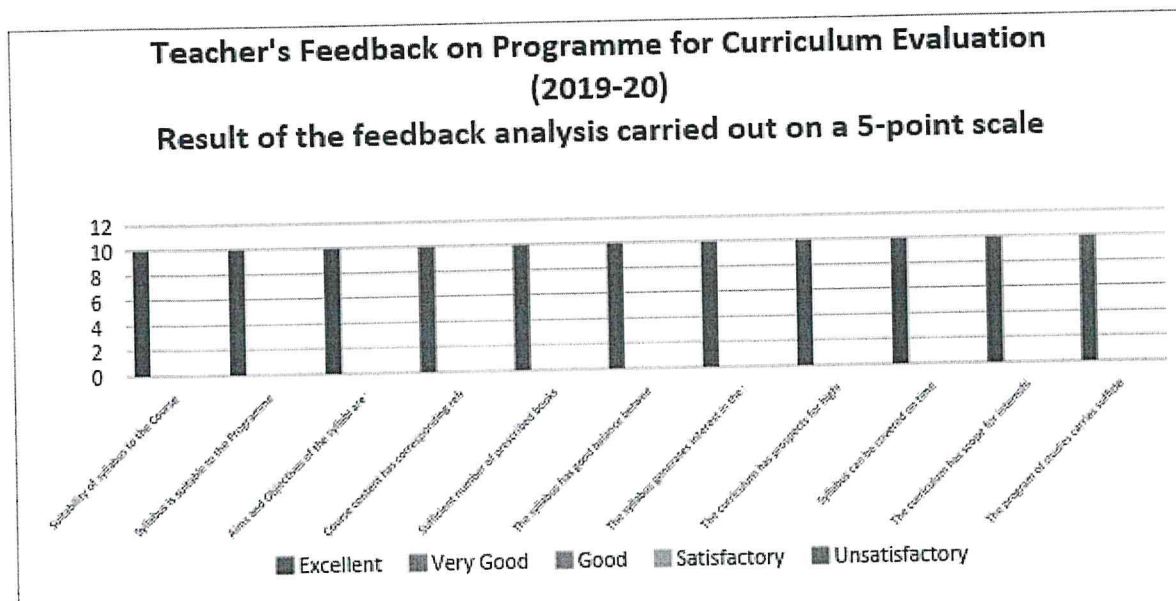

The students admitted to the UG and PG courses of English Language and Literature could attain a comprehensive knowledge of the new trends and tendencies in the discipline and the curriculum offers prospects for higher education, future research and employability. The latest syllabus revision has expanded the curriculum to include advanced topics. The books and reference materials in the prescribed syllabi were up to date.
