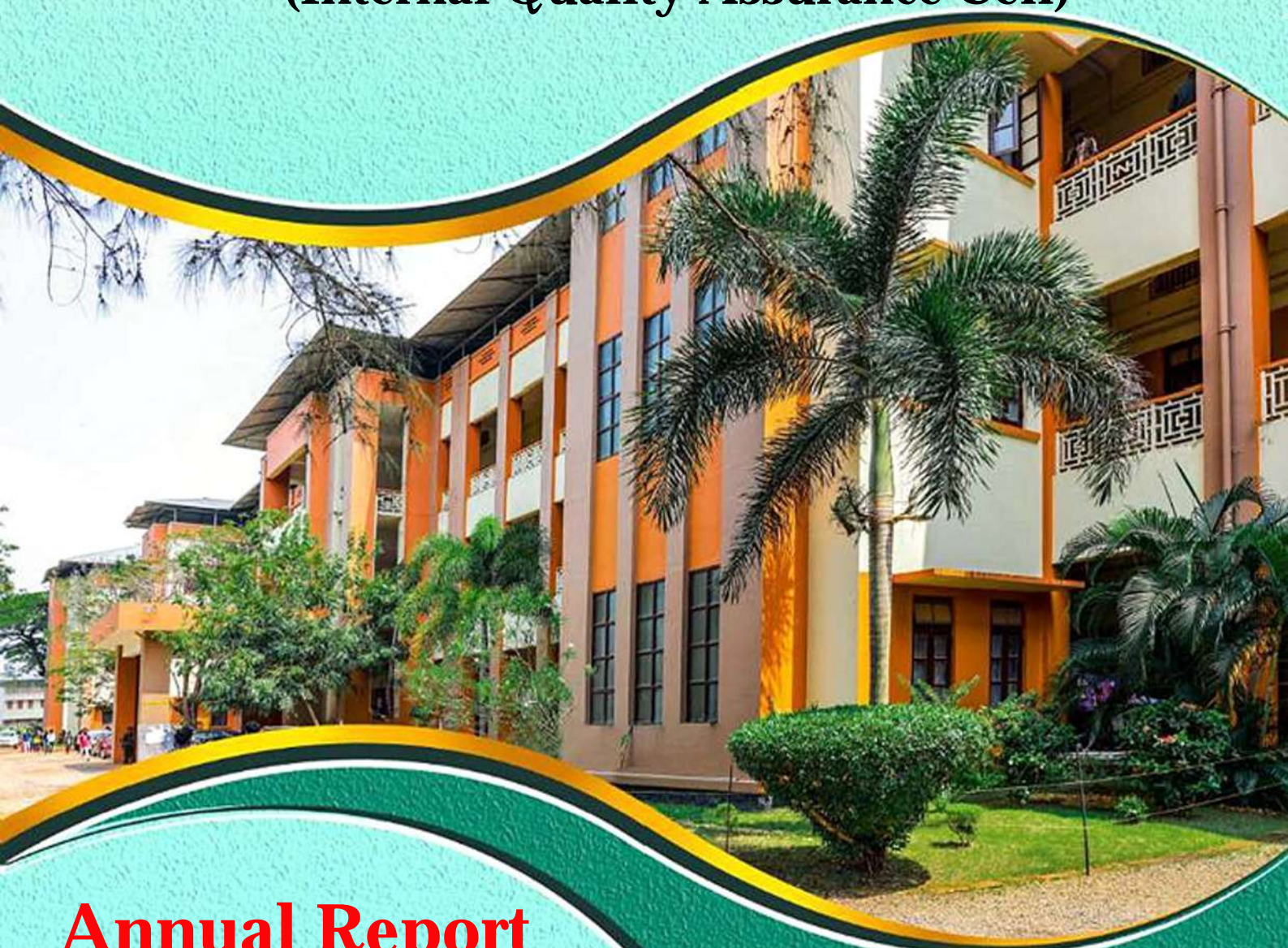

- For courses without practical examination, the internal assessment marks shall be forwarded within 15 days after the completion of last theory exam. For courses with practical examination the internal assessment marks shall be forwarded within in 10 days after the completion of last practical examination.
- In each Semester, classes are to be engaged at least for 90 teaching days or for 450 hours. Any deficiency in this shall be made good either by conducting classes on holidays/Saturdays or engaging extra classes on working days so that the minimum teaching hours (450hours) shall be completed.
- If any of the dates, prescribed in the calendar, happens to be a holiday, the next working day shall be the prescribed date for the academic event notified.
- The Academic calendar shall be strictly followed, and the internal assessment made accordingly for the timely submission of CA marks to the University.
- The Principals shall ensure that the students have the minimum attendance required for the previous semesters while registering them for University examinations and also ensure the minimum attendance required for the semester for which registrations were made while issuing the hall tickets.
- The colleges shall ensure that the Online registration of examinations are made complete by verification of the student registration at the required levels (Teacher Level, HoD Level, Principal Level).
- The attendance of students during the period of 80 days be taken for calculating the percentage of attendance for the Semester.

## **INSTITUTIONAL BEST PRACTICES**

### **BEST PRACTICES 1. “Share-and-Care”**

Sree Narayana College Kollam adopted Share and Care as one of its best practice with the objectives to provide mid-day meal to a minimum of 50 most needy students per day, to give financial assistance to socially and economically backward students and staff to meet medical exigencies, to facilitate possible welfare measures for deserving meritorious students who live on the edge of life and to extend emotional support and achievement motivation to the students who hail from the lower strata of society. Majority of the students who are admitted in our college are mostly from underprivileged families of socially and economically backward areas. On close observation of the impoverished daily living conditions of these students, we found that they encounter untold difficulties to meet the basic needs of their life; the prominent being the mid-day meal. Considering the pathetic situation, all the faculties of our college unanimously decided to pool in a required amount in order to offer a helping hand. In this circumstance, the practice named “Share-and-Care” came into effect in our college. In addition, a thought arose to increase the fund so as to help teaching and non teaching staff in some emergency situations. Thereon “Share-and-Care” started its functioning as a joint initiative of the teaching and nonteaching staff in association with the alumni.

In the academic year 2018-19 an amount of 4,32,000/ was utilized for the practice

### **BEST PRACTICES 2. Student Palliative Care Initiative**

Palliative care is dedicated medical care for people living with a serious disease. This kind of attention is intensive on imparting reprieve from the symptoms and stress of the illness. The goal is to improve quality of life for both the patient and the supporting family. Student Palliative Care (SPC) is one among the best practices of our college. SPC unit associate with palliative care unit of Kollam district to conduct the activities more effectively. We decided to focus our palliative initiatives on Cantonment Ward of Kollam District. The reason to choose these particular areas is that Cantonment ward is basically a railway colony. The residents of this ward have their homes on both sides of railway stations and rail tracks. Also, this region



is near to our college so we can easily intervene with the people there. With the support of govt palliative care unit and councillor of Cantonment Nagar we were able to conduct the health survey and identify the beneficiary patients. Palliative care unit consist of 57 volunteers.

In the year 2019-20 a survey was conducted with the objective was to understand the social, economic, and health status of people residing in Cantonment Nagar, Kollam. Based on the survey we included 52 patients in our list. This year palliative work commenced in the month of August. It took one month for the survey to complete. The field work stated in the month of September. The initial work started with the first instalment got from the Kerala University NSS. The work was carried forward by raising funds through palliative collection box placed at the campus in which faculties, students, non-teaching and all that come to campus can contribute for the activities. Details of the activities and photographs are shown below. Only those photos with prior permission of patients and their family members were included in the report.

#### **ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN**

- 1. HOME VISITS:** Usually home visits are done on second and fourth Saturday of every month by our volunteers. During the time of visit they interact with patients and their family members, collect the details of needed things such as medicines, food items, surgical items or any other help they needed
- 2. SUPPLY OF MEDICINS:** As per the details collected from the patients' medicines were supplied. Medicines for 30 days were given to them. Regularly medicines which they cannot afford or that is not supplied by PHC are purchased and given to the patients
- 3. DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD KITS:** In most of the visits the patients often demand for foods particularly fruits. Foods items were distributed to palliative patients accordingly. Food items distributed includes Apple, Orange, Watermelon, Grape, Pomegranate, Banana, Grocery items, Oats, Horlicks, Bread, Egg. Rusk, etc
- 4. DISTRIBUTION OF EQUIPMENTS:** Only a single patient demanded for walking stick which we were able to give. Walking stick was given to palliative patient Nelson who lives alone and find it difficult to walk without support.
- 5. DISTRIBUTION OF SURGICAL ITEMS:** Surgical items like water bed, belladonna plaster, under pad, diaper etc were distributed among the needed patients
