Report of ANTI RAGGING CELL - 2019 -2020

Anti-Ragging Committee for the Year 2019-20, formed under the Chairmanship of Principal, Dr. R. Sunil Kumar. Anti -Ragging Committee is constituted in our college to prevent ragging and to take anti ragging measures as per the guide lines issued by the Hon. Supreme Court of India & UGC. The undertaking by students regarding non-involvement in ragging act is introduced in admission process. Anti-ragging committee was reconstituted with senior and junior student representative, Sub Inspector of Police, East Police Station, Media Person (Asianet News),PTA representative, NGO, Representative from Non-teaching Staff etc.

Anti-ragging cell put Notice Board in the College premises as per UGC rules depicting the provisions of penal law applicable to incident of ragging and the punishment thereof.

Students were provided with college calendar detailing to whom he/she has to turn for help and guidance for various purposes, including addresses and telephone numbers so as to contact the concerned person at any time if and when required.

Anti-Ragging Committee/ Anti-Ragging squad conduct regular meetings, inform the fresher's in all classes about their right, and clearly instruct them about ragging. Fresher's of each department was assigned by a faculty member who

shall interact individually with each member every day for ascertaining the problems/ difficulties if any in the institution/hostel etc. Students whether victims or witnesses in any incident of ragging shall be encouraged to report such occurrence.

Posters showing Rules and regulations of Anti ragging are put up in and around the College premises like Notice Board, Departments, Common rooms, Canteen, Library and Hostels etc. to generate awareness amongst students on Anti-Ragging.

One incident of ragging has been reported inside the campus during the academic year 2019 - 2020. An enquiry was carried out in this matter by Antiragging committee and Antiragging squad and two female students were found guilty and reported the case to the East Police Station, Kollam. They were suspended from attending classes and other academic privileges for a month.

An Essay Writing Competition was organised by Anti Ragging Cell on February 13, 2020 to create awareness among Students and the first three positions were awarded with certificates and prizes.
